# Fleece Show Instructions

1. Fleece divisions and age divisions are listed above.
2. Each fleece entry must be accompanied by a copy of the animal's ILR registration certificate. Please place the certificate in the bag with the fleece. A photo of the animal is a nice addition.
3. Each fleece must have a completed Entry Tag in the bag with the fleece.
4. Fleece Preparation. Fleece Must Be:
  - a. Sheared, not brushed from the animal.
  - b. Consists of prime fiber from either the full blanket or barrel
  - c. Be sheared within 2 years of the date of the show
  - d. Have lock structure intact
  - e. Be skirted and handpicked
  - f. Be submitted in clear plastic bags
5. Fleece May Not:
  - a. Have guard hairs removed
  - b. Be washed after shearing
  - c. Have crème rinse or other chemical applied prior to or after shearing.
6. Finished Items:
  - a. Finished items must be 100% llama fiber.
  - b. All items must be made by the exhibitor.
  - c. Enter in the correct class – adult or youth.
  - d. Include a 3x5 card with information about how the item was made.
7. Mail In Items:
  - a. Send in application form & fees by May 5.
  - b. Mail entry to show so it arrives May 19 or before.
  - c. Include all entry tags.
  - d. Include \$6.00 for return postage.
